

HOW TO LOG INTO THE STUDENT HOME CLASSROOM

In Google (or any other search engine), type Melior Community Academy and open the website. You will see this at the top:



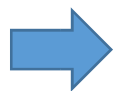
On a laptop, select “Curriculum at the top left. You will be taken to the page where you can see the link to the “Student Home Classroom”. Click on it.

If you are accessing the site on your phone, you will need to scroll down to find the “Curriculum” option. You should then click the link to the “Student Home Classroom”.

You will be asked to enter your Microsoft credentials. This is your normal school username, including any numbers, with a capital letter for the first letter of your surname, and a capital letter for your initial, in the format SurnameF, followed by @melior.org.uk.

So, for example, the username for Mickey Mouse would be MouseM@melior.org.uk

Your usual password may then need to be entered. If these two do not match, it may be that you have forgotten your username or your password and it will need resetting. Send a message via Schoolcomms, or to info@melior.org.uk and we will reset it for you.

You will then see the different Year group option boxes. Select the one relevant for you:



Next, you will see a timetable for each day and period of the week. Select the subject / time you wish and work on the tasks set. For example, Year 7 looks like this (currently)
